***Diamond* Tennis Racket (“the Racket”)**

I write in response to your request for an assessment of the conformity of the *Diamond* two-grip tennis racket, for which two samples were provided. The Racket features two grips, with a PU stabilising bar that joins each butt end together (see Figure 1).

The Racket has been reviewed by the ITF Technical Commission, which determined that it conforms to Rule 4 and Appendix II of the Rules of Tennis. The ITF has retained the prototype rackets as a record of this decision.

Please note that this decision is based solely on, and applies exclusively to, the rackets submitted for review, and not to any variations thereof. Please advise when the product is released into the market and re-confirm its brand name in order that it can be listed as a conforming tennis racket on the equipment conformity page of the ITF Technical website, www.itftennis.com/technical.

In advertisements for the *Diamond* tennis racket you are authorised to use the statement “Conforms to the official Rules of Tennis”. Use of the ITF logo and/or statements such as “ITF approved” or “ITF tested” is prohibited.

The ITF reserves the right to amend the Rules of Tennis and any interpretations thereof at any time and without prior notice.
